Teen Mystery Night

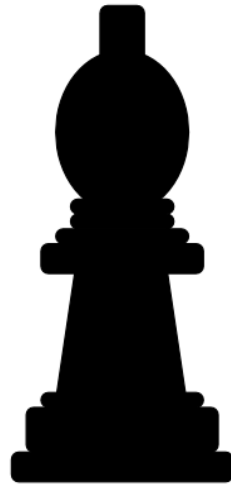
Saturday, October 22 from 7-10 pm. Come join us, play a character and try to find out "Whodunnit" - Refreshments will be served. Registration is required.

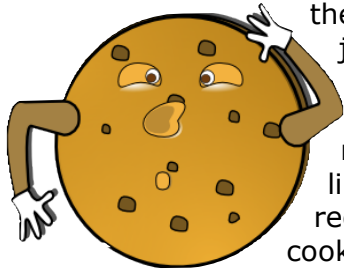
Pioneer Cooking
