The Galion Public Library is excited to announce the donation of an Orion Starblast Telescope to it's circulation starting this August. The telescope was a donation from the Warren Rupp Observatory, and made possible through a grant from the Fran and Warren Rupp Donor Advised Fund of the Richland County Foundation. Starting in August, adult patrons will be able to check out the telescope for one week at a time. The simple-to-use and light weight telescope comes complete with instructions on use.

Don't know much about astronomy? That's okay! When checking out the telescope, patrons will receive an interactive star wheel which will help them identify well-known constellations. Patrons will also be informed of various mobile apps and websites that may help users find and identify planets, constellations, and other structures of space. Whether you've never looked at the night sky, or have been studying astronomy for years, this will be fun for all of your friends and family!
