(Sixth graders from the 2014-2015 school year may participate in either the children's or teen program, and 2015 graduates may choose to participate in either the teen or adult program.)
- Those who wish to participate in the teen program can register beginning May 30th at the children's desk downstairs.
- After reading a book, teens will fill out a review form and enter it into the weekly prize drawing of their choice. Two \$10 gift cards drawings will be held each week (see schedule). Each participant may submit up to 10 book reviews per week.
- Read and review 5 books to receive a free book and 10 books to receive a 2nd free book OR a certificate worth \$5.00 off overdue fines.

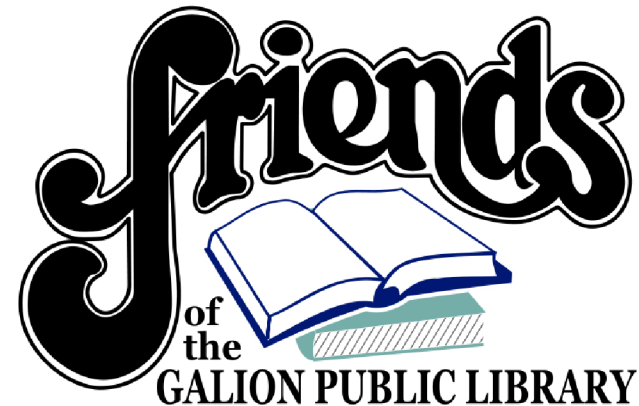

“The Friends of the Galion Public Library” is a group whose members are dedicated to helping the library by raising funds and purchasing items the library needs. They have 2 large book sales every year and also have smaller events throughout the year. Ongoing fundraisers overseen by the Friends include the sale of canvas library bags (available at the main circulation desk) and small carts of books available for purchase on both levels of the library.

Due to their efforts, the Friends are able to help provide funds for Summer Reading Programs - like paying for this special publication you're currently reading! - as well as computers, new materials (such as books, audiobooks, and DVDs), Young Adult Supplies, canvas Books on Wheels bags, outside Christmas decorations, and Christmas Open House expenses. The Friends additionally serve the library by volunteering to help at events and by providing refreshments.
